

Summary

The ResiLoop team are thrilled with the level of enthusiasm and engagement received since our most recent market update. This update covers activities between our recently established Stakeholder Reference Group meeting plans and discussions, engaging with industry recyclers and other interested stakeholders, and global collaboration.

Key Findings & Activities

Following a call for expressions of interest in our Stakeholder Reference Group, 27 senior decision-makers from across the industry, recyclers and interested stakeholders have joined the group and a meeting will be held in Melbourne Q4.

Technical Trial planning is underway, seeking quotes and scope for the project needs which has been shared with technical experts to assist in the review of suitable technology and to design a trial for reprocessing material in Australia.

We continue to raise awareness through a range of digital channels, including social media posting, website updates, and email send outs circulated by FCIA and the Property Council of Australia's Circular Economy Working Group.

We're investing time into global collaboration and have a forum with the US Resilient Floor Covering Institute and the European Resilient Floorcovering Manufacturers Institute to share research and information in the development of circular economy solutions for resilient flooring.

What's Next?

- Technology review and trials will continue, as we know that while some recycling can be done, there remain significant challenges to collect, sort, and decontaminate.

- Stakeholder Reference Group will kick off a workshop to uncover commonalities in the industry in relation to waste processes.

Design of reverse logistics trial to review, share, and gain feedback on from industry leaders and key stakeholders.
