## Key Findings & Activities

Our survey to installers is complete, gathering useful insights into current waste management practices and motivations, on and off job sites.

ResiLoop have commissioned Arcadis and Full Circle Advisory, advisers on circular economy, sustainable design and engineering solutions, to provide advice on suitable reprocessing technologies for floor waste streams aimed at optimising the value of the recycle(s) produced.

A potential process for recovery of floor waste from job sites has been proposed, which we have called Bag it, Box it, Book it, based on proposals from the supply chain and our global scan of similar schemes.

Commissioned a number of project stakeholders including consultants from Circular Design Thinking and PVC formulation technical experts to assist with the analysis and suitability of field trials, cost, and management of waste volumes.

The first Stakeholder Reference Group meeting brought together 24 representatives from logistics, manufacturing, distribution, installation and recycling to provide feedback on our proposals for waste recovery.
